**Chair's Report** J. Iverson provided the following report:

- a. Community engagement initiatives
  - i. Bike Fest is Wednesday, June 4. Key discussion items:
    - Paper flyers are ready to be sent home with students and a PDF version is ready for email.
    - Decoration materials are still needed (ribbons, fabric, stickers, etc.).
    - Volunteers are as follows: snack station (J. Iverson, V. Nguyen); mechanic station (D. Than); decoration station (S. Liu, B. Toews will check with teachers); ramp (volunteer who emailed the PAC); door prize draw (Ms. Ting, C. Iverson). Arrive around 2:30 pm.
    - To purchase and be reimbursed: spoke beads (D. Than), snacks (J. Iverson).
    - School will provide tables, mic, speaker, etc.
    - For the bike to school week contest, teachers need paper ballots and a bucket. One ballot per day each time students roll to school. Ballots include name, division, date. Grand prize draw at 2:45 pm on Friday, June 6.
  - ii. Spring Carnival is Wednesday, June 18. Key discussion items:
    - The Community Centre does not have a rentable popcorn machine. J. Iverson will source other options.



- Ms. Ting secured the Secret Society of Books' Bookmobile, a traveling bookshop. The van will park on the gravel soccer field on the primary side.
- The school is providing a \$400 food budget, which the PAC approved using for pizzas. C. Iverson will shop for other food (fruits, veggies, desserts, drinks, etc.).
- To discuss at next meeting: decorations (definitely inside, maybe outside), outdoor games, BINGO supplies (incl. \$100 in Tim Hortons gift cards for game winner), volunteers.
- iii. R. Wong has applied for the PNE Community Grant Fund. Could put funds toward a back-to-school event or the Meet the Teachers and PAC Night. R. Wong will report back in due course.
- b. Upcoming PAC initiatives and deadlines
  - i. Nothing to report in terms of PAC outreach. Carry item over to next meeting.
  - ii. Sports Day is Friday, May 23. The PAC approved providing either watermelon or freezies, depending on what the school requires.B. Toews will confirm requirement.
  - iii. TCBY Frozen Yogurt requires a minimum number of orders, so the PAC decided not to proceed with TCBY for the treat stand on Friday, May 30. Instead, the PAC will purchase ice cream sandwiches and host a sale. \$1 per treat. Action: C. Iverson to seek sponsorship from Superstore. R. Wong to make flyers to send home. B. Toews to ask the Student Council to help with the sale.
  - iv. Grade 7 graduation activities are a work in progress. Key discussion items:
    - J. Iverson has secured the caricature artist. Next step is getting student pictures from the teachers.
    - Picnic lunch is Friday, June 20. PAC is providing pizza, chips, drinks. Pizza to be delivered to New Brighton Park. Students can have up to three pieces of pizza each. J. Iverson coordinating.
    - Farewell ceremony is Thursday, June 19. PAC is providing cupcakes (100).
    - Booking Rio Theatre for a movie experience. J. Iverson is coordinating. B. Toews is providing date.
