FIT – Flexible Instructional Time

The purpose of FIT blocks are to:

- provide students with time and flexibility to meet with teachers for support, guidance and inspiration regarding curriculum or other passions and interests,
- collaborate with students, teachers or community members; and
- explore, work on, or complete assignments and projects.

Student Expectations:

- be learning focused in a classroom or learning space, with a teacher
- be completing schoolwork (either individually or in groups), or meeting with teachers for support on classwork, or working on projects under teacher supervision or getting caught up on missed work.
- be signed up for a FIT session (VSB FIT Planner)

Learning Hub

Moving towards more inclusive supports.

Gr. 8 & 9 students will be supported in the following ways:

- FIT (4 x 40 minutes per week): possibly a targeted program, students are signed up and committed to certain days / times
- WITHIN the academic classes: possible push-in, specific time in the Hub, Hub teachers working with classroom teachers

Allows students to access support as needed, throughout the year.

Allows ALL students, not just those with IEPs, to access support as needed.

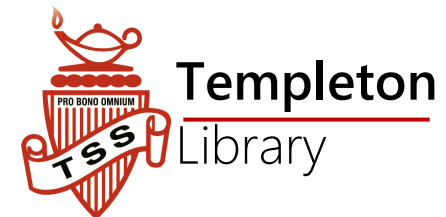




My Education BC - MyEd
