- Online School Opportunities
 - North Island School District and VSB offer BC Curriculum courses online
 - online courses can be explored for extra credit work, summer school, or to allow opportunities for mark grade improvement
 - Grade 8 & 9 VSB funding allows for either online or in person school course credit for the full school year
 - Grade 10 & 11 & 12 VSB online program allows for credit per course models that can be added to in person school course schedules or to help pursue courses not offered at KG
 - All VSB approved online and in person courses contribute toward KG graduation credits
 - interested parents should consult with KG Staff for online Vancouver Learning Network (VLN) counseling regarding opportunities and limitations for online learning modules
- Outdoor Basketball Court vs Outdoor Classroom Garden / Outdoor Recreation Spaces
 - pavement issue deemed KG outdoor basketball surface unsafe to play on. VSB provided a grant to make the space an outdoor classroom and garden. Parents discussed possible fundraising ideas to properly pave and return area to an outdoor basketball court (approx \$10,000-20,000)
 - KG school field can be used at lunchtime if students ask a member of the office staff to open the field gates and supervise any low-risk sports activities
 - West End Community Centre (WECC) tennis courts can be used by students from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, Monday - Friday, and students can use school supplied tennis equipment
 - parents discussed opportunities for KG school field repair and rental income
 - parents discussed opportunities to encourage community relationships with local businesses of the West End Neighbourhood and to pursue recreational opportunities in nearby Stanley Park
- Walking Tour of KG School - Tyler
 - parents were invited to join a guided walking tour within the KG school building
