



On Our Way to Kindergarten at Gordon!

We are thrilled to welcome you, your child, and your family to the Gordon Community. As we prepare to start the school year in September, we aim to ensure a smooth and successful transition for our youngest learners through a **Gradual Entry Schedule**.

Gradual Entry Schedule:

- **Sept. 8th:** No school for kindergarten students.
- **Sept. 9th:** First Day of Kindergarten Gradual Entry
- **Duration:** September 9-15

During this period, students will start with shortened days in smaller groups. Gradually, their time at school will increase towards a full day. This approach allows children to get acquainted with their kindergarten teachers, school staff, socialize, play, and explore different classrooms.

What to Bring:

For gradual entry, your child will need a snack and a water bottle. Once your child is placed in their kindergarten classroom, please ensure they have the following items:

- **Backpack:** Large enough to hold their lunch bag and book bag (which they will receive from their teacher).
- **Water Bottle:** With a straw, **no screw tops** (these tend to spill in the classroom and their backpack).
- **Change of Clothes:** In a Ziplock bag (underwear, shirt, pants, and socks, empty Ziplock bag (for soiled clothing) – **all labeled**).
- **Indoor Shoes:** No laces unless they can tie them independently. They need to be suitable for running, as they will wear them during PE.

Kindergarten Survey:

This is your chance to share valuable information about your child to help us support them throughout the year.



Optional Parent Teacher Meeting:

If you feel there is additional information we should know about your child, you are welcome to sign-up for a 10-minute meeting with one of our kindergarten teachers. Please note that the teacher you speak with may not necessarily be your child's assigned kindergarten teacher. Meetings will be held from September 8th to 11th between 11:30 AM and 12:30 PM.

These meetings are intended to provide us with more information about your child not covered in the Kindergarten Survey. We will discuss class routines and expectations at our Kindergarten Kickoff. Additionally, we will have parent-teacher conferences in October, which will give us an opportunity to discuss your child once we have had a chance to get to know them better.
