

# Reminder emails about library books once each term:

If your child has a book that is lost, overdue or damaged they are welcome to keep borrowing books from our school library. **Book Bin for each child:** Sometimes parents and students ask about how to keep track of school library books and home reading books at home. My recommendation is to use a basket or bin system: one basket for school library/home reading books and a separate basket for public library books. Some families prefer to keep the baskets in bedrooms (that's what I do) and some prefer a space near the door. If a book from our library is returned to the public library it will get back to us in about a month. In turn, if a public library book is returned to our library, I will return it to the VPL
