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

★ TALENT SHOW – FRIDAY, JUNE 13TH ★ ***UPDATED INFORMATION AND TIME ADJUSTMENT***

This year's talent show audition process saw unprecedented interest by our students. To accommodate the 27 acts (53 students) that will be performing, we will be splitting the show into two portions:

- 9:15 am show for our primary performers (Grades 1-3)
- 1:15 pm show for our intermediate performers (Grades 4-7).

Then we are hoping to plant some seeds for a summer crop. Please stay tuned for a garden watering sign up schedule, so that we can get the beds watered during the summer.

A newsletter with the September 2025 Livingstone School start-up plan will be emailed to families in late August to confirm the first few weeks' plan.


