Kindergarten Registration for 2024-2025

Registration is a two-part process.

Step 1: Complete and online application form.

Step 2: Verifying Documentation

- **Contact** your catchment school to set up an appointment to bring your supporting documentation.
- **Bring supporting documentation** to your catchment school during your scheduled appointment.
 - FOR CHILDREN BORN OUTSIDE OF CANADA: Book an appointment with a Registrar at the Newcomer Welcome Centre (NWC) to complete your registration (an appointment booking link will be provided in the confirmation email after submitting your application - step 1). Please note, NWC visits are by appointment only. Please email the NWC at nwc@vsb.bc.ca if you do not receive a link to their bookings page to book an appointment.

The following original documents must be presented to complete your application:

- 1. Proof of British Columbia residency
- 2. The original birth certificate of the child
- 3. Applicable Immigration/Citizenship/Permanent Resident Documentation
- 4. Immunization Records if available

[Note: Some schools may request additional identification as proof of residency.] **NOTE:** Some catchment schools do not have space for all students even if you apply before the January 31 deadline. In these cases there will be a draw for student placement mid-February and the school will contact you by late April to confirm your enrolment. * Available Space includes physical capacity, resources, staffing, or educational programs available or planned for a school as defined by the District (Administrative Procedure 300).

District choice programs

Families must register at their neighbourhood catchment school during the priority registration period (November 1 - January 31) before applying for Kindergarten Choice programs.

Applying for a District choice program is a separate process and runs from January 8 to February 2, 2024. Visit the <u>Kindergarten Choice Programs</u> page for more information.

Cross-boundary Registration

Families who wish to apply to a school outside of their catchment area, known as crossboundary, will register their child at their neighbourhood catchment school first. Applying for cross-boundary is a separate online process and runs from February 1 - 29, 2024. Cross boundary applications will only be considered after all in-catchment students have been accommodated.

How to Apply Cross Boundary:

<u>Step 1:</u> You MUST register at your <u>English Catchment School</u> BEFORE submitting a cross boundary application.

<u>Step 2:</u>

Complete an online Cross Boundary Application form

<u>Step 3:</u> The school will inform you of the status of your application by: March 31

Priority categories for cross boundary applicants are:

- 1st: Non-catchment student with a sibling concurrently attending the same program has a sibling that will be concurrently attending the same location, in the same program
- 2nd: **Non-catchment student** (Daycare) A student resident in the School District enrolled in child care within the catchment (applies to Kindergarten Grade 7 only)
- 3rd: Non-catchment student A student that is a resident within the District
- 4th: Non-District student A British Columbian resident who does not reside in the Vancouver School District

Please note that the online Cross-Boundary Application form is for English program cross-boundary applications only. French Immersion cross-boundary applications are submitted directly to French Immersion school offices.
