

# OUR SCHOOL POLICY

- Portable electronic devices to be used with teacher permission.
- Portable electronic devices are not for unstructured time. Such as before and after school (8:40-9:00 and 3:00-3:20) or at recess and lunch.
- Portable electronic devices are the student's responsibility and the school cannot be responsible for the loss or damage.

## CONSEQUENCES FOR INAPPROPRIATE USE

1. Students using these devices during the school day, without staff supervision, will first receive a warning.
2. IF a repeated incident occurs, the device will be kept in the office until 3pm that day.
3. If this continues to occur, the device will be kept in the office until picked up by the family.
4. "In the office" means: locked in a room or drawer by the admin or office assistant.
5. Classroom teachers will be notified if a student is having difficulty following the guidelines or has been given multiple warnings.

## HOW FAMILIES CAN HELP:

1. Discuss the pamphlet with your child.
2. Encourage your child to follow the guidelines our school has created.
3. Come in and talk with staff if you have questions.
