Cutlery

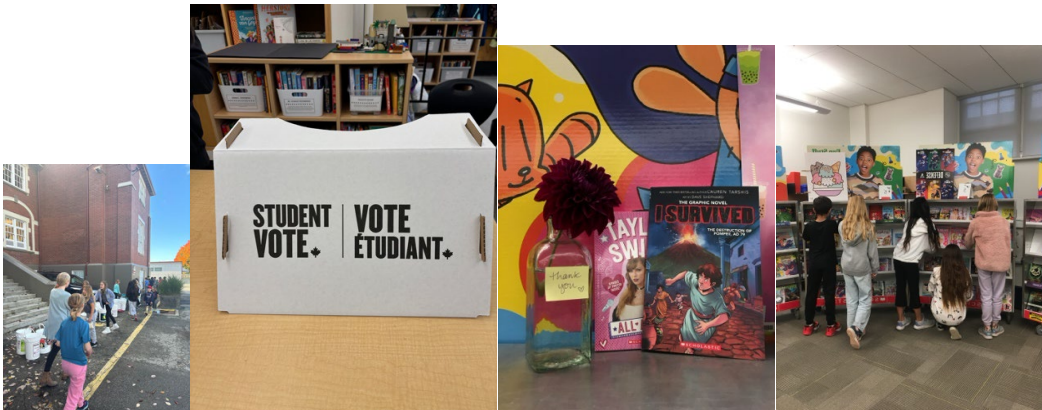
Please remember to send your child with the appropriate utensils for their lunch. We do not supply forks, spoons, chop sticks etc.
