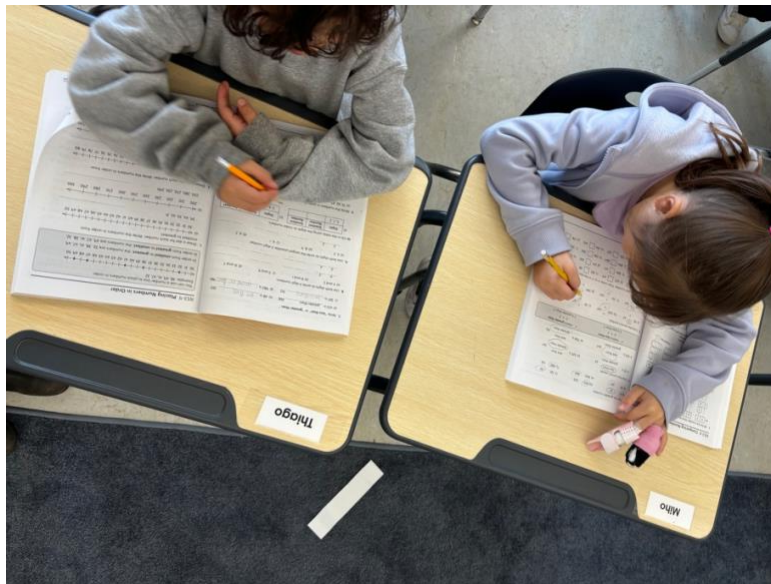

We had our first fire drill of the school year on Wednesday and all staff want to thank the students (and especially our new kindergarten students) for how well they did during this important drill.

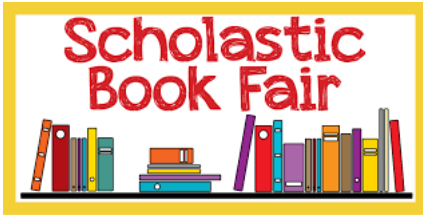


Important Opportunity for the Cavell Community – School Travel Planning Initiative
