

I hope your child came home to let you know that we had Erin Fox, Terry Fox's niece, visit our school as a Terry Fox Ambassador on Tuesday. She is proud to carry on the legacy of her uncle and is part of both the Terry Fox Foundation and the Terry Fox Research Institute. She spoke about the power of resilience and the lasting impact that one person can make when they dream big. She spoke directly to our students, and this was very impactful. You may also have heard she brought a replica of Terry's prosthetic leg with the Adidas runner attached. I was asked to carry the prothesis around the school for students to see and even touch for some. I was very surprised at how heavy it was, and she spoke about Terry's distinctive run style. He needed to take two strides with his good leg prior to lifting and propelling the prosthetic leg forward as it was not made to be run in. It sure isn't the carbon fiber prosthetic legs of today. Our Terry Fox run is on Thursday, September 18th and our goal is to raise \$5000. Erin told us that over Cavell's 34 years of hosting a Terry Fox Run we have raised \$105,000! Way to go Cavell. It is not lost on us that many school runs happen in September which also happens to be Childhood Cancer Awareness Month.
