**Earthquake Drill – Thursday, Oct. 16 at 2pm**. For any students who are new to Gordon this year we are requesting you join us for the earthquake drill. Please refer to the yellow form sent home regarding the proper ID to provide for pick up. This will be your chance to see how the pick-up procedures work in case of a real emergency. Once you pick up your children please proceed directly home, and do not stay to play on the playground.

Your participation also allows us to practice our procedures and make improvements as needed. We will start the drill just before 2pm with the goal of being outside at 2pm. Please do not arrive at school before then. We will not be ready for you. Also, please note that we will endeavor to process as fast as possible, but there is a chance we will not be able to reunify you with your child(ren) by the time we are scheduled to head back inside (2:40pm approx.). If we cannot get to you in time, we apologize. In the event of an actual earthquake and reuniting with families, we would not expect all families to descend upon the school at the same time, so a drill is only an approximate replication of a real earthquake scenario.

Also, it is vital that your yellow form is updated and accurate. We will not release any child if the information is inaccurate (even though we may know you). Please ensure it has been filled out and returned to the office. If you need another copy, extras are available in the office. This is in following our strict VSB Guidelines. This is our assurance to you that we are keeping your child(ren) safe and not releasing students to unauthorized people.
