



SOUTH HILL EDUCATION CENTRE ADULT AND CONTINUING EDUCATION STUDENT ELIGIBILITY GUIDE

To ensure that students provided with tuition free courses in Adult Education meet BC Ministry of Education and Child Care eligibility and residency requirements, we ask students to take the following steps.

Step 1	You must be ordinarily resident in BC and at least 16 years old on July 1, 2025
Step 2	<p>Provide a copy of one of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Indigenous documentation or band card• Canadian Birth Certificate and Photo ID or Canadian Passport• Confirmation of Permanent Residence and photo ID• Canadian Citizenship card or certificate and photo ID• Refugee Claimant documentation and photo ID• IRCC Confirmation of Permanent Residence being processed within Canada and photo ID• Work Permit in effect for one year or more and Photo ID and indication of employment in BC<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Work Permits must also be in effect for the duration of the period of study○ International Students who also hold Work Permits are not eligible for tuition free funding○ Work Permit holders are employed for at least 20 hours per week in BC <p><u>If the above document does not include an official photo, please provide one of the following types of photo identification (ID):</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• BC Driver's License• BC Services Card or BC ID• Passport from home country with name clearly visible <p>Please visit our New Students page for further instructions.</p>
