- Ms. Rhead suggestions for PAC support/funding include Saleema Noon Programming, 30 MacBook laptops and 1 charging cart, games and toys for primary classrooms and lunch clubs, possible curling program, new book sets for intermediates, playground equipment, more game lines and beautification along the primary wing outside corridor, endless opportunities.
- Other discussions included:
- Money to help the music teacher, Ikea Kallax boxes would be great to store musical instruments, strings need to be replaced, any amount from the PAC would be appreciated. The allocated amount was $\$ 400$, it was reduced to $\$ 200$.
- Grade 7 expenditures for 2023, previously, about \$15/student was given and there are 62 grade 7's this year.
- The allocated amount for the trophy case was $\$ 3000$, a smaller case is now in the making at $\$ 1500$.
- Technology fund has been our main focus; we were planning to fundraise \$40,000-\$50,000 towards laptops and carts. Suggestions were made to spend this money in increments. Ms. Rhead has recently purchased a used iPad mini cart, with refurbished laptops and 3 new ones thus were a past emergency, not much of an issue right now.
- New projector is needed in the library; the projector and installation will be approx. $\$ 2000$.
- A motion was put forth by Deljit to approve the budget, it was seconded by Lucia and the vote was passed unanimously.

- Learn more about the provincial government's StudentandFamily AffordabilityFund. In late August, the provincial government announced one-time funding to BC school districts to help address some of the rising costs students and families currently face. Of the $\$ 60$ million in funding, the Vancouver School Board will receive slightly more than $\$ 4.7$ million. Based on school size and community make-up, schools will receive between $\$ 15,000$ and $\$ 100,000$ to support the following priorities:
- Food and nutritional support for students and families,
- Supporting Families and Offsetting Costs

Any leftover chocolates will be donated to the Grade 7, they can sell them to help fundraise for their Grade 7 graduation event.
