



Photography 9 – 12 ~ 1000's of pictures are taken each day, but how do you make your image stand out and tell your perspective of what you just encountered? Do you ever wonder how photographers in National Geographic are able to make you think or feel differently just another looking at one image? This course is designed to give students a working knowledge of how the principles and elements of art and design are used within photography to tell a story. Photo-shoots will be assigned that challenge students to think about what they see in their environment and in turn, to create a dialogue with the viewer with their work. Understanding of a digital SLR camera will be reviewed along with skills needed to edit (Adobe Creative Suite), create Time-lapse videos, sequences and more. (This is a technical course that requires a focused and mature student.) (NOTE: A personal camera is not required for this course, cameras can be borrowed from the school.)

Music / Rock Band ~ *Have you ever wanted to be* in a band? Does the idea of forming a group with your peers and learning music of your choice sound like fun to you? Then KG Rock Band is the place for you! Contemporary Music is a course designed around building musicianship through engagement with the music of your choice with peers of your choice. This course offers a less traditional approach to music learning, focusing more on learning by ear, chord reading, listening skills, and collaboration. This course is open to instrumentalists and singers with varying degrees of experience, from absolute beginners to expert rockers.







Combine high school instruction with paid, part-time, on-the-job training and receive credit towards apprenticeship and high school graduation.

Program Details

The Youth WORK in Trades program allows students to start their apprenticeship training while enrolled in Grade 10, 11 or 12.

- Earn up to 16 high school credits when a formal SkilledTradesBC agreement is signed by the employer, student, parent/guardian, and school district.
- Receive a Youth WORK in Trades certificate upon graduation.
- Must be employed in a recognized trade area.

Students considering an apprenticeship in a construction trade could contact careerprograms@vsb.bc.ca and ask to be enrolled in the BC Construction Safety Alliance SiteReady construction safety course. Instructions on completing the registration process for SiteReady are available here.

English Language Proficiency


- Up to 9 ways to meet this requirement
- UBC/SFU require students attended at least four (4) years of high school in Canada or in another English speaking country
- Other universities may require applicants attended an English speaking high school for 2, 3 or 4 years
- May require TOEFL/IELTS exam
- Waiver form: available for student and English teacher to complete stating student is fully proficient in English *(not guaranteed to be accepted)

English Language Proficiency

So, if you attended a school in Canada or another country where English was first language of instruction, in:

- **Grade 8**: OK
- Grade 9: OK (full year)
- Grade 10: Require IELTS/TOEFL assessment or Waiver for UBC, SFU and maybe Capilano U.
- **GRADE 11/12**: REQUIRE IELTS/TOEFL for both SFU, UBC and CapU and maybe other specific programs.
