





Admission Requirements: High School Graduation

<u>CERTIFICATIONS</u>: Citation, Certificate, Diploma, Degrees*

*Associate Degree (University Transfer Program)– 2 yrs

Transfer into 3rd and 4th year at UBC, SFU, UVIC, etc. (less cost, smaller classes, more supports)

Application opens October 1st - first come first serve


English Language Proficiency

- Up to 9 ways to meet this requirement
- UBC/SFU require students attended at least **four (4) years** of high school in Canada or in another English speaking country
- Other universities may require applicants attended an English speaking high school for 2, 3 or 4 years
- May require TOEFL/IELTS exam
- Waiver form: available for student and English teacher to complete stating student is fully proficient in English *(not guaranteed to be accepted)
