Hello KG families and students.


We are well into June and we are almost there! Just a couple more weeks...and it is starting to feel like summer.

Youth Community Pass Program Competition

Mobi by Rogers is partnering with the Vancouver School Board and the City of Vancouver's School Active Travel Program to provide King George secondary school students with affordable access to bike share.

For \$20 students can get a year of access to bike share through this subsidized program!

The Youth Community Pass is valid for 365 days and includes unlimited 60-minute trips on classic bikes.

Bikes can be unlocked from stations all over the city and returned to any station in the system area, making bike share ideal for short, one-way trips. Bike share is proven to improve physical health, mental health, access to recreational programs, and even opens up job opportunities!
