## Semester 2 Final Learning Updates

Student Learning Updates were published on the MyEd BC family portal yesterday. Please login to your child's account to view their Learning Update for final marks for Semester 2.

Please note the following information regarding access to MyEd BC over the summer:

- Semester 2 final Learning Updates will be available online in your child's account until July 24, 2025 – please ensure to login to the account to view and download the Final Semester 2 Learning Update prior to that date.
- **All MyEd BC Student Family accounts will be suspended by 11:59pm August 8, 2025.** Students attending the Summer Learning program should view and download their Learning Updates upon course completion.
- There will be no access to accounts or the published learning updates after August 8, 2025. Students and/or parents should download, save and/or print a copy of the Learning Update for their records.
- Returning students' accounts will be reactivated on the first day of school. Accounts will be accessible by their last successful login ID and password.

## Graduating Students and Students Leaving VSB

Effective July 1, Microsoft 365 login accounts for graduating students and those leaving the Vancouver School Board (VSB) will no longer be operational. Students should ensure they transfer any OneDrive files to a personal account before this date. SpacesEDU allows users to retain login access by changing their email to a personal one through the account settings.

Canva accounts can also be converted into personal accounts by applying for conversion in the account settings. Once converted, data and account access will be released. For added protection, all Microsoft data will be permanently deleted on August 1, 2025.
