Track and Field

Track and Field is starting! Anyone interested in being on the school track and field team this year, please sign up with Mr. Jack in the PE office. Pre-season training will take place at 7:45 am, in the gym, every Tuesday and Thursday in February. Starting in March, most practices will be after school from 3:30 to approximately 5 pm at Camosun Park (days of the week have not been determined yet). Some specialty practices, like hurdles and high jump, will continue to take place in the mornings. Competition days are also to be determined. A full schedule will be available after Spring Break. Also, after Spring Break, meetings will take place every Monday at lunch in the main gym. If there is no school on a Monday, the meeting will be on a Tuesday.

The Track and Field team is the largest team in the school. It is co-ed and all grades. We don't make cuts (no one will be eliminated from the team). The team won 11 City Championships in a row ending in 2023. Last year, we placed second to Kitsilano, so this year we will try to recapture the title. Despite our competitive nature, we are still an all-inclusive team. We encourage students of all abilities to join. Managers are also needed. The Track and Field team is a great way to get involved at Byng, work on your general fitness, improve your strength, power, speed, and endurance for another sport, or make new friends.

If your son/daughter has a medical condition: diabetes, seizures, anaphylaxis, asthma, or other medical concerns, please come to the office to pick up a medical care plan form. It is important that the school is informed of any medical condition that may require emergency care at school and have updated information on file.

It is strongly recommended that students who carry emergency medications such as inhalers, epi-pens or diabetic emergency kits keep these medications or supplies with them at all times in a fanny pack, purse or backpack which travels to class and on field trips with them.

New Applicants to the Program -

Auditions took place on February 1st and 2nd during the semester turnaround days.

We are currently reviewing each application, artwork, and auditions as we work on creating a list of offers. You are one of approximately 300 applicants seeking a seat in our Byng Arts program. That is close to three applicants for every available seat. We wish that we had enough space for everyone, however, we are working with the spaces that we have. If you do not get an offer, we hope that you will continue to seek out creative opportunities and continue to follow your passion for the Arts.

We will email all applicants on February 28th with the results of our First Round of Offers. This will include either a message with an offer, a message with no offer, or a message indicating that the applicant is on our waitlist and still under consideration for the second round of offers. If offered a seat you will have until March 1st to respond. A second round of offers will go out March 6th.

For students in Grades 8 to 11, offers will go out as soon as we determine our available seats in each grade – this may happen after the second round offers go out – please be patient.


Byng Arts Passport:
