Gr.10-12 Credits

What do you need to graduate?

- 80 credits total (4 credits per successful course)
 - 52 required Gr. 10-12 core academic courses, CLE10, CLC12, and PE10
 - 28 elective credits (7 courses), one ADST or Arts 10-12 At least 4 Gr. 12 courses
- Provincial Literacy 10/12 + Numeracy Assessments 10
- Indigenous-Focused Graduation Requirement
 - Ex. EFP11, EFP12, BC First Peoples 12

 Additional credits can be earned through BC Ministry of Education <u>External Credit Programs</u> (Ex. ICBC Drivers Ed., Canadian Red Cross Society, Royal Conservatory of Music, Scouts Canada, Girl Guides of Canada, etc.)
 *Ask counsellor for more details.

2-Step Process (PSI)

1. Application to PSI

- Do your research!
- Know application deadlines!
- Make informed decisions!
- Have options

2. Send Transcript for evaluation

- Student Transcript Service (STS)
- Sign up for BCeID (email verification)
- View your official transcript
- Send Official Transcripts to schools
- Give schools permission to view your transcript (date)
- Direct from Ministry of Ed BC

Different Pathways

- Everyone's pathway is different!
- Plan for post-secondary transfer with BC Transfer Guide.
- GPA for PSI transfer is less competitive than direct from Secondary.

Action Plan

Application/Acceptance Timeline (approximate)

- Applications open: Oct
- Early Admission deadline: Nov Dec
 - There is no advantage to submitting first!
 - Only recommended for students with competitive Academic Average (Gr.11-12)
- Regular Admission deadline: Jan Feb
- Admission decisions: Mar June
- Course completion/Graduation: June
 - STS to send final transcripts!
