

Gr.10-12 Credits

What do you need to graduate?

- 80 credits total (4 credits per successful course)
 - 52 required Gr. 10-12 core academic courses, CLE, CLC, and PE10
 - 28 elective credits (7 courses), one ADST or Arts Education course required
- At least 4 Gr. 12 courses
- Provincial Literacy/Numeracy Assessments
- Indigenous-Focused Graduation Requirement

- 
- Additional credits can be earned through BC Ministry of Education External Credit Programs (Ex. ICBC Drivers Ed., Canadian Red Cross Society, Royal Conservatory of Music, Scouts Canada, Girl Guides of Canada, etc.) *Ask counsellor for more details.

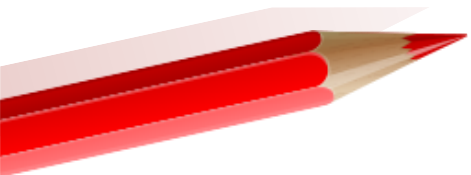

Math Options (Gr.10-12)



Workplace Math

- Gr. 10 – 11
- Graphing, units, surface area & volume, trigonometry, central tendency, probability, financial literacy
- College or bridging institutions



Foundations Math

- Gr. 11 – 12
- Geometry, trigonometry, linear inequalities, quadratic functions, stats, and proportional reasoning
- Arts & Social Sciences faculties
 - Archeology, Communications, Criminology, History, International Studies, Political Sciences, and Psychology, etc.

Pre-Calc Math

- Gr. 11 – 12
- Real Number System, Operations on powers w/ rational exponents and radicals, exponential functions, rational expressions & equations, quadratic functions and equations, trigonometry, financial literacy
- Science & Business faculties

Math 11 is required for GRADUATION.

2-Step Process (PSI)

1. Application for PSI

- Do your research!
- Know application deadlines!
- Make informed decisions!

2. Student Transcript Service

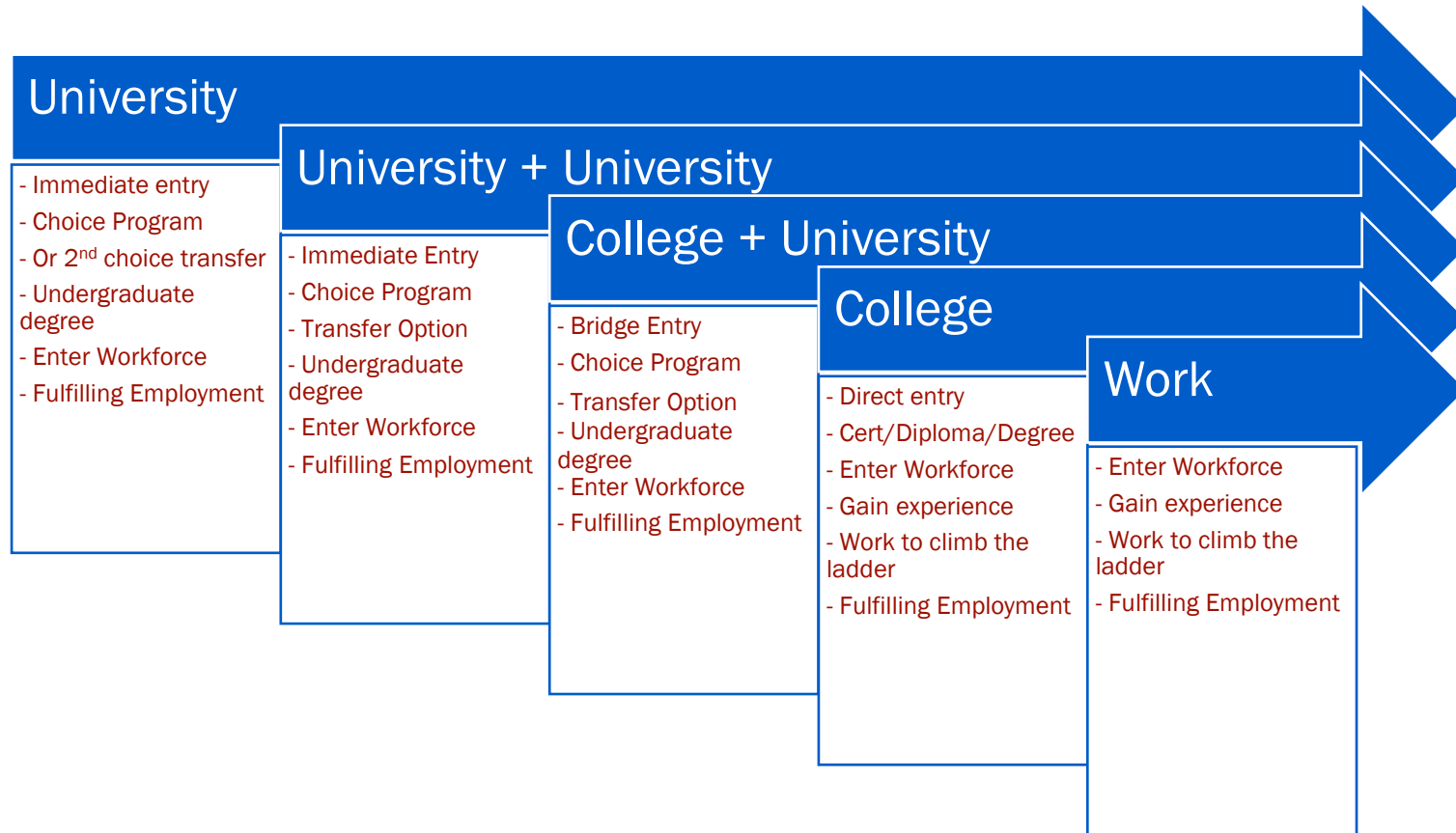
- Sign up for BCeID
- Send Official Transcripts to schools
- Give schools permission to view your transcript (date)



Some schools will ask for informal transcripts (DVR), sealed/stamped school transcripts in mail, or self-reported grades.

Different Pathways

- Everyone's pathway is different!
- Plan for post-secondary transfer with [BC Transfer Guide](#).
- GPA for PSI transfer is less competitive than direct from Secondary.



It is always in a student's best interests to have a back-up plan!

Action Plan

Application/Acceptance Timeline (approximate)

- Applications open: Oct
- Early Admission deadline: Nov – Dec
 - *There is no advantage to submitting first!*
- Regular Admission deadline: Jan
- Admission decisions: Jan – May
- Course completion/Graduation: June
 - *STS to send final transcripts!*

All deadlines and requirements may be PSI specific. Please check websites for accurate information!



Action Plan

Submit Course Requests

- Log on to [MYEDBC Portal](#) and enter Course Requests
 - Portal open for window of time
 - Changes can be made up to the deadline
 - There is **NO ADVANTAGE** to submitting first/early
- Submit back-up paperwork to Grade Counsellor for record keeping.
- Final schedules will be shared before the school year.
 - Timetable is created based on Course Requests and teaching loads
 - Course Requests are not guaranteed
 - Graduation is top priority
