Shaughnessy Traffic

Please continue to follow the **Traffic Safety Plan** for our school and review the image to familiarize yourself with the plan if needed. It involves several schools and Shaughnessy parents should drive east on Nanton and North on Marguerite.

- The drop off/pick up zone is for a quick drop off and pick up only.
- Parents MUST stay in their car.
- Vehicles should move forward in this zone and let children enter/exit when you get to the front of the line (this is important so that cars do not back up and block the intersection on Nanton Street)
- Do not turn into private driveways or U-turn on the street.
- Do not stop your car in the crosswalk. Leave this area clear for students and families to cross. We encourage all families to use the crosswalk.



It is best to walk, bike, or park a few minutes away and walk to and from school with your children to avoid congestion.

Leaving Children Unattended in a Car

Please remember that leaving your child alone in a car can have extremely dangerous and serious outcomes. In some cases, it also can put your child's life at risk. According to Canadian law, it is a criminal offense if you leave your child alone in a parked vehicle. If you need to exit your vehicle, kindly park on side streets and accompany younger children to the school during pick-up and drop-off times. The safety of all children is of utmost important to us.

Are You Moving?




