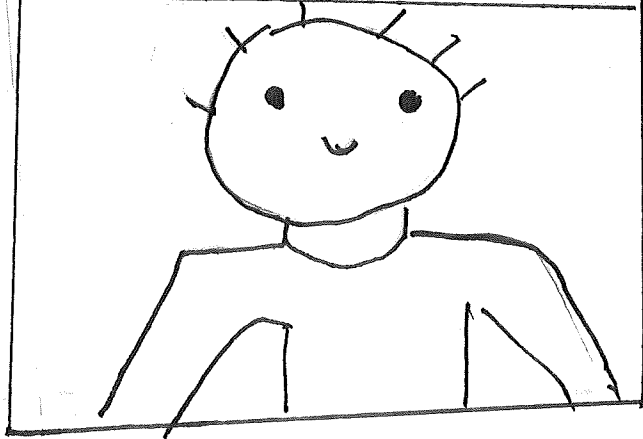

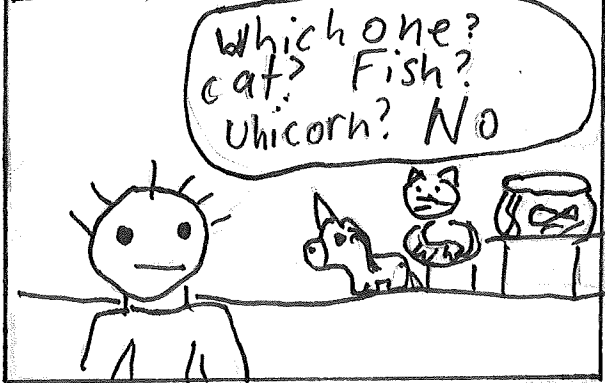
This is Joe You might remember him from the November comic.



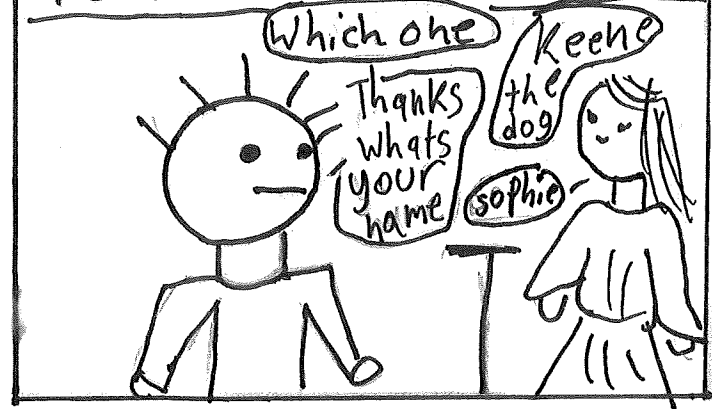
Joe is happy now But he wants a new pet



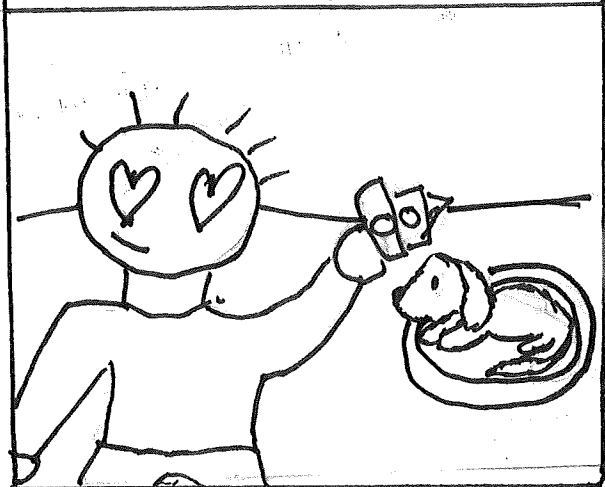
Joe didn't know what one to buy so he went to the pet store.

So Joe loved Keene so he bought him

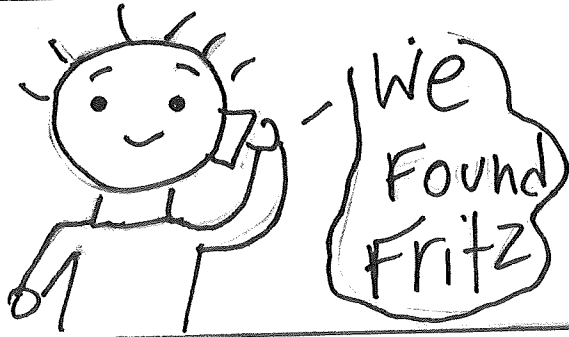

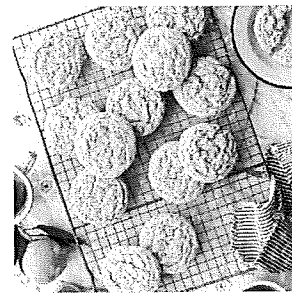
Lemon Cookies

Prep Time: 20 mins

Cook Time: 12 mins

Total Time: 32 mins

Serves 12 large cookies



This yummy lemon cookie recipe is from *The Minimalist Kitchen Cookbook* by Melissa Coleman.

Ingredients

- 2¼ cups all-purpose flour, spooned and leveled
- ¼ cup cornmeal
- 2 tablespoons poppy seeds
- ½ teaspoon baking soda
- ¼ teaspoon sea salt
- ½ cup unsalted butter, at room temperature
- 1 cup granulated sugar, plus more for sprinkling
- 1½ teaspoons lemon zest
- 1½ teaspoons orange zest
- ¼ cup extra-virgin olive oil
- 1 large egg
- 2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice

Instructions

1. Preheat the oven to 350°F and line a baking sheet with parchment paper.
2. In a medium bowl, whisk together the flour, cornmeal, poppy seeds, baking soda, and salt.
3. In a stand mixer fitted with the paddle attachment, cream together the butter, sugar, and zests on medium speed until well combined. Add the oil, egg, and lemon juice. Continue mixing until pale and evenly combined, about 1 minute, scraping down the sides as needed.
4. Add the dry ingredients to the creamed ingredients, mixing on low speed until just combined. The dough will be somewhat dense.
5. Using a 1/4-cup sized cookie scoop, scoop the dough onto the prepared baking sheet (note: these cookies will spread, so leave some room in between each one), and sprinkle the tops with sugar. Bake for 12 minutes. The cookies will seem like they need a minute longer, but take them out anyways. Let cool on the pan for 1 minute before transferring to a cooling rack to cool completely.

Notes

Tip: to bring butter to room temperature more quickly, cut it into skinny shreds, exposing as much of the surface area as possible.

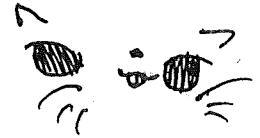

It is now held in Mr. Kitts room 201.

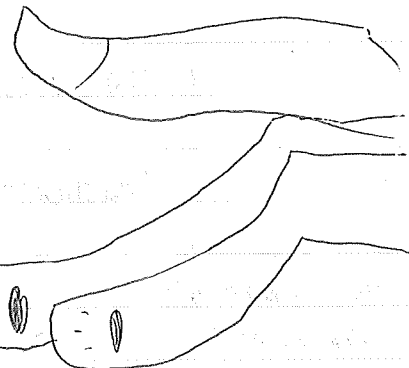
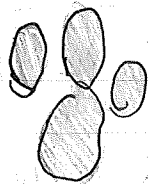

Devils Hole Pupfish, The Rarest Fish in the World

The Devils Hole pupfish (*Cyprinodon diabolis*) is an endangered species found only in Devils Hole, a water-filled limestone cave in Nevada, USA. This community of pupfish lives in a shallow area of only 20 square meters (215 square feet). Studies suggest the fish colonized this cave in the last few hundred to a few thousand years ago which could have happened through human intervention.

Devils Hole pupfish mainly eat the algae that grows on the limestone and small invertebrates. Diatoms are a major food source in the winter and spring along with *Spirogyra* algae in the summer and fall. They will also consume any possible food source.

It is an extremely small fish ranging between 2.3cm (0.9 inches) to a maximum of 4.3cm (1.7 inches).

Coloration varies depending on age and gender: males are bright metallic blue while females and juveniles are more yellow.

Reproduction happens year-round with spikes in the spring and fall. Females produce a small number of

eggs and the survivorship from egg to adult is little.
They usually live 10 to 14 months.

This species has a small population which hovers
around in the 3 digits. Extinction could occur in
approximately 360 to 2900 years with less than a 2%
chance of living 10,000 years.
