# Vancouver School Board Updates Downtown Catchment Boundaries

The VSB has updated catchment boundaries in the downtown area to accommodate the new school in Coal Harbour, which has been named Seaside Elementary School. The school also carries gifted names from our host nations:

- **cəwas** from x<sup>w</sup>məθk<sup>w</sup>əyəm (Musqueam)
- səlilwəta+ from Tsleil-Waututh Nation
- Ch'elxwá7elch Skwuláwtxw from Skwxwú7mesh Úxwumixw (Squamish Nation)
