🌟 Black Excellence Day

Yesterday, some classes acknowledged Black Excellence Day as part of our lead-up to Black History Month in February. This day is dedicated to celebrating Black history, amplifying Black voices, and learning about the rich contributions of Black Canadians through stories, art, and culture. It's also a time to stand in solidarity and reflect on the ongoing fight for civil rights.

Black Excellence Day, created by the Ninandotoo Society, is observed annually on January 15th—a date chosen to honour the legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., born on January 15, 1929. Alongside his remarkable impact, we acknowledge the achievements of Black Canadians and the struggles that are too often overlooked in our history books.

At Thunderbird, we remain committed to bringing diverse perspectives into our classrooms and examining historical injustices, so that we can learn from the past and work toward a more equitable future.

The Vancouver School Board, District #39, and its students, staff and parent community are participating in the 2026 Ministry of Education's electronic and anonymous [Student Learning Survey](#) in cooperation with all other school districts throughout the Province. Parents/Guardians of grade 4 and 7 students at Thunderbird can complete this electronic anonymous survey **any time before May 1, 2026**.

This survey is intended to help the Ministry of Education and school districts plan – allowing parents and students to tell us about their education experience in their school and district. Students in Grades 4 and 7, and their parents and all staff in B.C. public schools are invited to take the annual online satisfaction survey about their school experience.

For parents to complete the survey:

1. Go to any computer that has up-to-date internet browser access at home, work, or school and access: <https://www.awinfosys.com/SurveyFull1/central/main/access.asp>
2. Scroll down to the “**Parent**” section - Direct Access. Select **39 Vancouver** from the pull-down menu next to **District**. **The school** will then appear, and you select **Thunderbird šxʷəxʷaʔəs Elementary**. You can then select your desired language and click the **Log On** button.
3. Complete the survey by clicking on the “radio buttons” for each question. Move to the next set of questions by clicking on **Arrow Button** in the bottom right corner of the screen. If you make a mistake, you can click the back **Arrow Button**.
4. When you have finished the survey, you will get a message thanking you and you are done.
