Students in Grades 4 and 7, and their parents and all staff in B.C. public schools are invited to take the annual online satisfaction survey about their school experience.

### For parents to complete the survey:

1. Go to any computer that has up-to-date internet browser access at home, work, or school and access: <https://www.awinfosys.com/SurveyFull1/central/main/access.asp>
2. Scroll down to the “**Parent**” section - Direct Access. Select **39 Vancouver** from the pull-down menu next to *District*. *The school* will then appear, and you select **Thunderbird šxʷəxʷaʔəs Elementary**. You can then select your desired language and click the [Log On](#) button.
3. Complete the survey by clicking on the “radio buttons” for each question. Move to the next set of questions by clicking on **Arrow Button** in the bottom right corner of the screen. If you make a mistake, you can click the back **Arrow Button**.
4. When you have finished the survey, you will get a message thanking you and you are done.
