





Junior Arts 9/10

This course works as an overview in the visual arts. Drawing, painting, ceramics, sculpture, printmaking, ink and illustrations are all focused on as projects.

Senior Arts 11/12

This course is open to students of all skill levels and works as a transition to post-secondary arts and creative programs with regular opportunities with the Vancouver Art Gallery and with engaged projects with things such as screen printing, murals and more.



Photography 10-12

For grade 9 photography please select Photo 10.

This course works as an introductory course in working as a photographer using school equipment. Students are given a Adobe Creative Cloud license for the semester as well. Camera basics and techniques are taught along with Photoshop editing.

This is a mixed grade level course; students will be enrolled grades 9 through 12.

A senior component is available for engaged and mature students looking for further opportunities. Please check with Mr. Sinclair if you are curious.




TEXTILES 9 - 12



Combine high school instruction with paid, part-time, on-the-job training and receive credit towards apprenticeship and high school graduation.

Program Details

The Youth WORK in Trades program allows students to start their apprenticeship training while enrolled in Grade 10, 11 or 12.

- Earn up to 16 high school credits when a formal SkilledTradesBC agreement is signed by the employer, student, parent/guardian, and school district.
- Receive a Youth WORK in Trades certificate upon graduation.
- Must be employed in a recognized trade area.

UBC English Language Competency Requirement

- Up to 9 ways to meet this requirement
- UBC require students attended at least **four (4) years** of high school in Canada or in another English speaking country
- Other universities may require applicants attended an English speaking high school for 2, 3 or 4 years
- May require TOEFL/IELTS exam
- Waiver form: available for student and English teacher to complete stating student is fully proficient in English *(not guaranteed to be accepted)

SFU English Language Requirement

Requirement Type:

- Completion of last **three (3) years** of full time secondary school in English, in a country which the principle language in instruction is English
- Completion of **four (4) years** of education in an INTERNATIONAL school in a country where English is NOT the principal language

1. Register for a BCeID
2. Create a Student School Transcript Services (STS) account
3. Log in to STS and Select colleges/universities you will be applying to. Complete by “Ordering” transcripts (free).

 - Focus on career skills for employment
 - ASSOCIATE DEGREE (2yrs)
 - University Transferable to year 3 & 4 to UBC, SFU, UVIC, CapU, etc
- UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE
 - Bachelor's Degree
 - BA= Bachelors' of Arts
 - BSc= Bachelors' of Science
 - BEd.=Bachelors' of Education
 - GRADUATE DEGREES
 - Masters (MA/MSC, etc.)

University Transfer from College

- **ASSOCIATE DEGREE** (2 years)
- Post Secondary institutions have programs which are collaborative where students can apply to transfer to a bigger university to complete their degree. AKA: “ladder up” or Bridge”
- LANGARA, DOUGLAS, VCC, CAPU
- TRANSFER to UBC, SFU, UVIC, CAPU
- Require minimum GPA to transfer

Ontario Universities Application Centre- OUAC

- Fee: \$150
- (Includes 3 program choices)
- Additional university choice(s): \$50
- PEN # required

Must apply through OUAC first!

OUAC will then contact Ontario universities
to send application package to student.

Deadline for completed applications to OUAC
is January 15, 2021.
