- Once you have chosen three preferred electives, please choose three alternate electives, in order of preference in case your first-choice electives are unavailable or will not fit into your timetable.

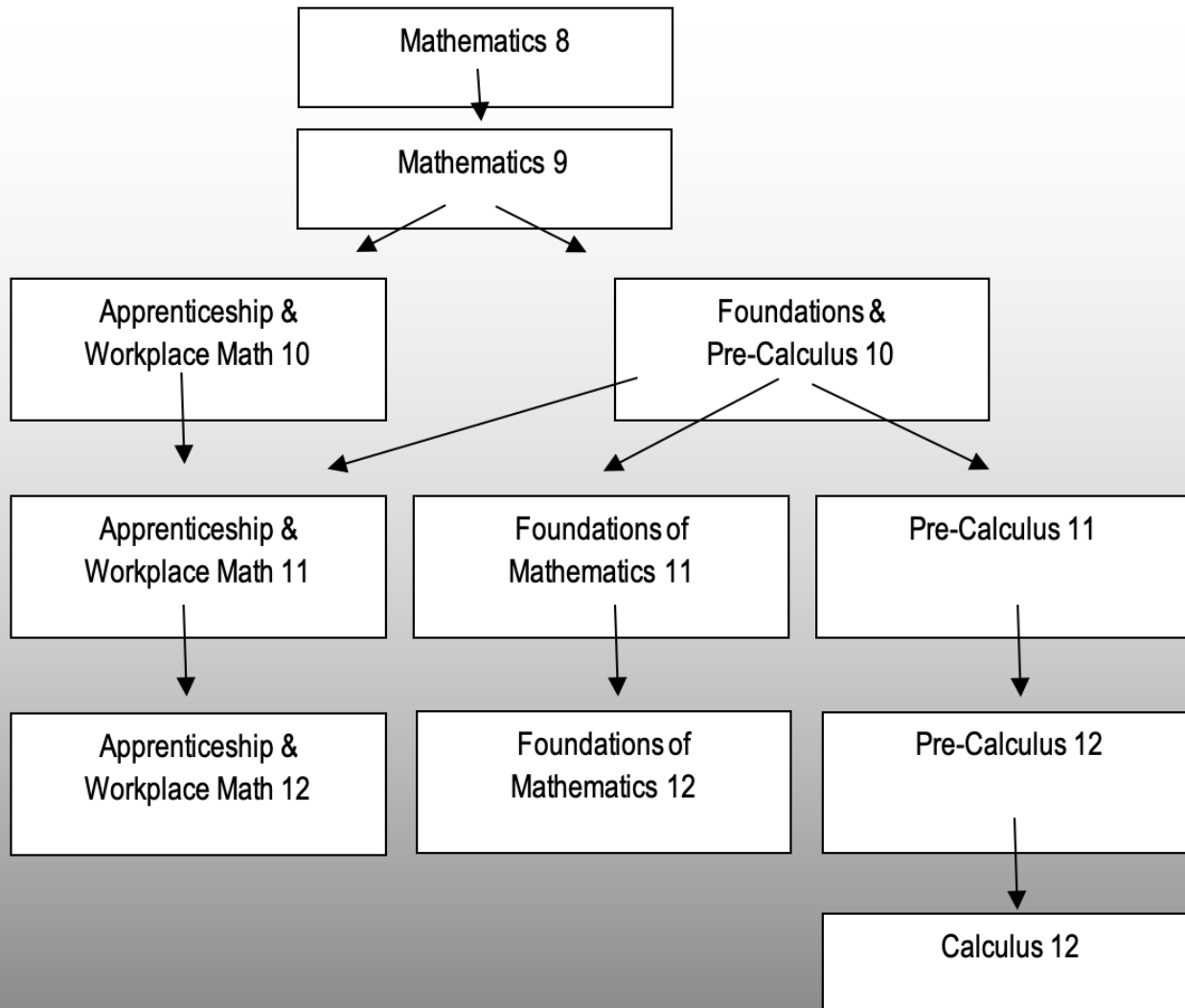

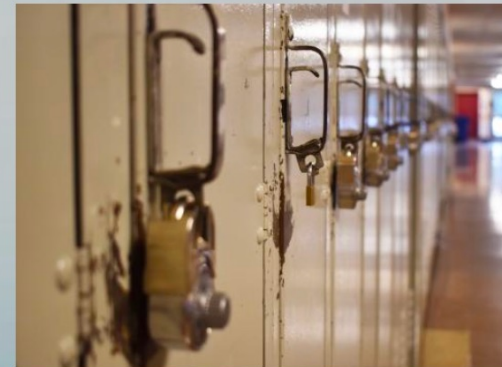
# Photography 10-12

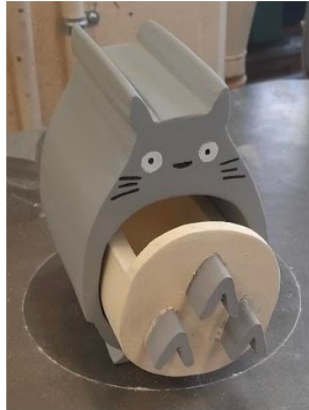

Students will advance their programming skills in game design, web development, UX design, and data science by building on HTML, CSS, and Python, and introducing JavaScript, to create interactive web content and applications, applying an iterative design process and exploring the broader impact of technology.

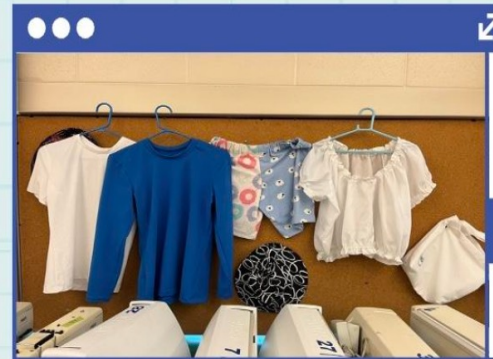
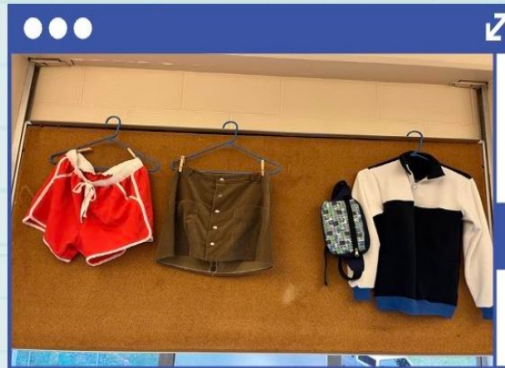




# TEXTILES 9 - 12
