Moving towards more inclusive supports.

Gr. 8 students will be supported in the following ways:

- FIT (4 x 40 minutes per week): possibly a targeted program, students are signed up and committed to certain days / times
- WITHIN the academic classes: possible push-in, specific time in the Hub, Hub teachers working with classroom teachers

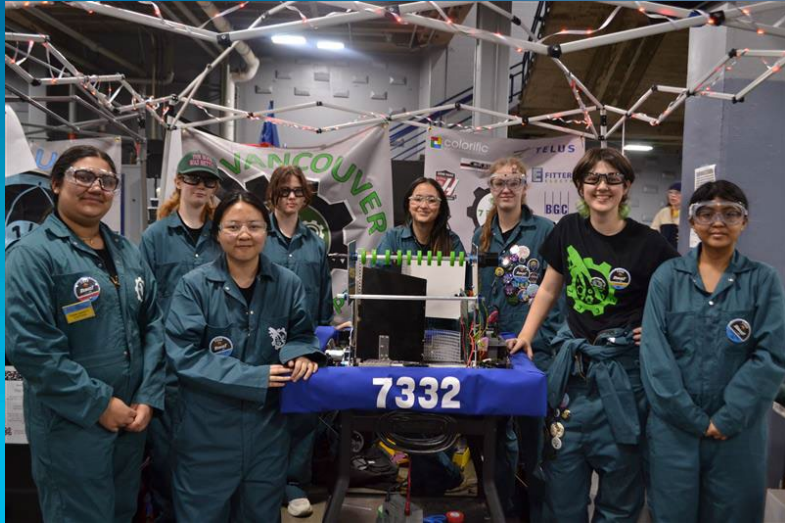
