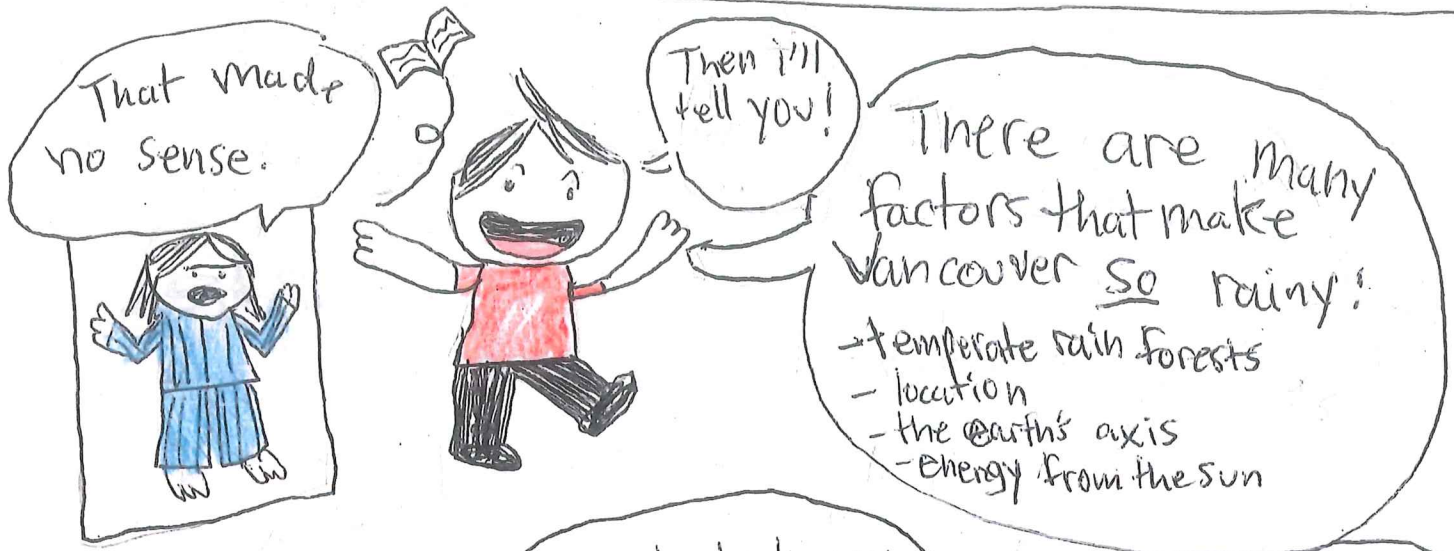


# RAIN

# BROWNIES

## Ingredients:

- ½ cup butter
- 1 cup white sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ⅓ cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- ½ cup all-purpose flour
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- ¼ teaspoon baking powder

## Directions:

Step 1: Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Grease and flour an 8-inch square baking pan.

Step 2: Melt 1/2 cup butter in a large saucepan. Remove from heat, and stir in sugar, eggs, and 1 teaspoon vanilla. Beat in 1/3 cup cocoa, flour, salt, and baking powder. Spread batter into prepared pan.

Step 3: Bake in the preheated oven until top is dry and edges have started to pull away from the sides of the pan, about 25 to 30 minutes

What is sleep paralysis? Well, sleep paralysis is when you're awake but temporarily can't move and you see a man or a shadow. During sleep paralysis, the person may hallucinate, which results in anxiety.

This happens because of a disruption in the sleep cycle. Sleep paralysis occurs when you become aware while either still in or transitioning out of REM (Rapid Eye Movement) sleep. Normally, your body is paralyzed during REM to stop you from acting out your dream, but this paralysis continues shortly after you wake up and is called REM atonia.

An episode can last between a few seconds to a couple minutes. The episode usually ends on its own or when someone touches you. Using extreme effort to move can also end an episode.

There are two types of sleep paralysis: Isolated sleep paralysis and recurrent sleep paralysis.

Isolated sleep paralysis is when sleep paralysis is isolated without any signs of sleep disorders.

Recurrent sleep paralysis involves multiple episodes over time and can be associated with narcolepsy.
