Hello Beaconsfield Parents/Guardians:

I wanted to introduce myself. I am Nancy, the school counsellor. I am a counsellor at 3 schools and I am at Beaconsfield Elementary every Thursday and alternating Mondays. Here is a mental health resource I'd love to share with you:

Kelty Mental Health Resource Center is a community and online resource that supports families in navigating the mental health system in B.C. The website helps families find support (referral process and access to parent peer support workers). If families need a translator at the medical appointments, they are free. The website has valuable information on healthy living, challenges and disorders, substance abuse, medications and therapy, and an online resource library. There are multi-language resources for mental health information, translated medical sheets and translated types of therapy on the website. Accessibility is great. There are events, webinars, podcasts and even an app for youth, called 'Breather,' to help practise mindfulness. There are phone lines on the website to help families with children/youth who are having mental health or substance use crisis. https://keltymentalhealth.ca

Kindergarten Registration for 2025-26

Kindergarten registration for children born in 2020 has begun.

All Kindergarten applicants are required to submit an application to their English catchment elementary school. This includes families who wish to apply for choice programs (French Immersion, Montessori, etc.) and/or a cross boundary placement.



Registration is a two-part process.

Step 1: Complete an online application form

Step 2: Verifying Documentation

- **Contact** your catchment school to set up an appointment to bring your supporting documentation
- **Bring supporting documentation** to your catchment school during your scheduled appointment
 - FOR CHILDREN BORN OUTSIDE OF CANADA: Book an appointment with a Registrar at the Newcomer Welcome Centre (NWC) to complete your registration (an appointment booking link will be provided in the confirmation email after submitting your application step 1). Please note, NWC visits are by **appointment only**. Please email the NWC at nwc@vsb.bc.ca if you do not receive a link to their bookings page to book an appointment.

The following original documents must be presented to complete your application:

- Proof of British Columbia residency
- The original birth certificate of the child including parent names
- Applicable Immigration/Citizenship/Permanent Resident Documentation
- Immunization Records if available

[Note: Some schools may request additional identification as proof of residency.]

NOTE: Some catchment schools do not have space for all students even if you apply before the January 31 deadline. In these cases there will be a draw for student placement mid-February and the school will contact you by late April to confirm your enrolment.

District choice programs

Families must register at their neighbourhood catchment school during the priority registration period (November 1 - January 31) before applying for Kindergarten Choice programs. Applying for a District choice program is a separate process and runs from January 7 to February 4, 2025. Visit the <u>Kindergarten Choice Programs</u> page for more information.

Cross-boundary

Families who wish to apply to a school outside of their catchment area, known as cross-boundary, will register their child at their neighbourhood catchment school first. Applying for cross-boundary is a separate online process and runs during the month of February 2025. Cross boundary applications will only be considered after all in-catchment students have been accommodated. More information can be found on the district website, under cross boundary registration.

Kindergarten Registrations Received AFTER January 31st

In-catchment Kindergarten students who apply **after** January 31st will be accommodated if there is space. If there is no space their names will be added to the bottom of the existing waitlist. ***Note**: There will be **no priority** given to registrants with siblings if they register after January 31st.
