Red Dress Day / Monday 5 May

- Red Dress Day is a poignant event in Canada dedicated to honouring and raising awareness about the thousands of Indigenous women, girls, and Two Spirit, Transgender, Non-Binary, and Gender-Diverse people who have gone missing or been murdered.
- This day was inspired by The REDress Project: https://www.jaimeblackartist.com/exhibitions/, an art installation by Métis artist Jaime Black, who hung empty red dresses in public spaces to symbolize the absence of these individuals and to confront the public with the stark reality of violence against Indigenous communities.
- The red dresses serve as a powerful visual reminder and a call to action, urging society to acknowledge and address this ongoing human rights crisis.
- Please wear red at your schools and find a way to honour these lost lives, ensuring their stories are not forgotten and their voices are heard.
