IE Days: Jan. 27 & 28

IE Days are Mon, Jan. 27 & Tues, Jan. 28. On these days, your child may be asked by specific teachers to come in to receive additional support, complete outstanding work, and/or demonstrate skills required for success in the course. If requested by teachers, students are expected to attend. If not requested by teachers, students are not required to be at school. Teachers will be informing students and parents about IE Day attendance by January 22, 2025.

The first day of semester 2 is Wednesday, January 29.

Semester 1 final reports and Linear 1st reports will be published in MyEd at 2pm on Thursday, January 30.

If your child is unable to log in, they must contact the main office for assistance.

STUDENT LEARNING SURVEY


Help us plan for the future! Students in Grades 10-12 and their parents are invited to participate in an annual online satisfaction survey about their school experience.
