# 3. First week back to school in September Schedule for Tuesday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>:

Returning Tyee Students from Grades 1 to 7 attend from 9:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.

- Please report to last year's classroom door or meeting spot at 9:00 a.m.
- Families, please pick up your child(ren) from these same doors at 10:00 a.m.
- PAC will be hosting a "Welcome Back" coffee hour for parents to attend while their child is here for the hour.

# New Students to Tyee Grades 1 to 7 attend from 9:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.

- Please meet in the front entrance to the school (Dumfries Street). A staff member will meet you there and bring your child into the library.
- Students will be moved to age-appropriate classrooms on Wednesday, September 3rd.
- A teacher will let you know which door to pick up your child at drop off time.

Starting on Wednesday September  $3^{rd}$  all students in Grades 1-7 will attend for full days, which is from 9:00 a.m. to 2:58 p.m.

- Students are to pack a snack, lunch, and water bottle to school each day.
- All students will report to, and be dismissed from, the same classroom door or designated meeting area for this week. We anticipate that all students will be placed in their new classes for the year by the end of the first week back to school.

Please note: Grade 1 students (last year's Ks) will be in library starting on Wednesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup> so that new Kindergarten students can participate in gradual entry.
