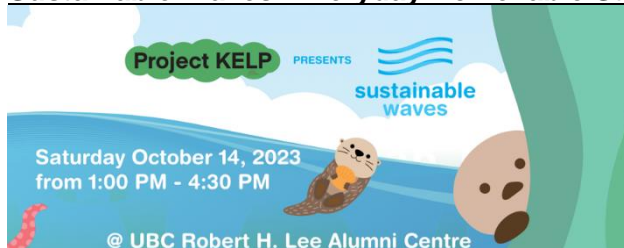
Shad Canada
