Principal Moro:

There has been no formal survey. Some teachers have needed to adjust their scope and sequence of their course because they have less time to cover a course. So far they have been making adjustments, with most offering opportunities for extra help for students. There are pros and cons.

Has asked the district about plans for getting feedback from teachers. There is no formal feedback process this year. Guessing that the district will look to get feedback at the end of the next school year.

Discussion included how some FIT sessions are monitored and others are not, the choice and ownership given to students to take responsibility for how they choose to use their FIT sessions, and that it may work better for some students than others.
