Short Answer Test Strategy: RACE

R ESTATE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Restate the question by changing it into a statement
A NSWER	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Answer the question• Answer all parts of it
C ITE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cite the evidence• Tell where you found the details
E XPLAIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Explain your answer• Give evidence from the readings and text

Extra tips:

- Read each question carefully
- Highlight key words that might change your answer
- Check how many marks a question is worth to determine the length of your answer
- Write clear sentences
- Avoid words like *I believe* or *I think*
