



# Kindergarten registration for children born in 2021 begins on November 1



A reminder to families with incoming Kindergarten students in September 2026, to complete an online application for your English catchment elementary school prior to January 31st. Once you receive an appointment at the school, please submit copies of the required documents: Proof of residence in Vancouver, Child's birth certificate, Immunization records, Immigration documentation (if applicable) and Court orders/documents (if applicable).

The **second step** is to apply online for **Early French Immersion** or other **District Choice Programs** between **January 6 and February 3, 2026**. This applies to all students, including incoming siblings. We will forward the link after the Winter Break.



Please check out the Lost & Found before the end of term, when items will be donated to a charitable cause.


The Lost & Found rack is located on the main floor of the school, at the north end of the corridor by the gym entrance.
