



Winter Concert - Tuesday, December 16 - 6:00 to 8:00 pm



The concert will take place in Byng's auditorium. Students will have the opportunity to see each other perform during a dress rehearsal on the afternoon of December 16 during school hours.

Student Supervision:

- School staff have kindly agreed to make themselves available from 5:30 pm until the end
 of the concert to supervise students. Please email your child's teacher if your child will
 NOT be participating.
- Band students (Divisions 1, 2 and 3): Please arrive at the JQ music room by 5:30 pm to unpack instruments before going to the Byng auditorium.
- All other students: Please arrive between 5:30 and 5:45 pm and go to your classroom.
 Students will wait with school staff in their classrooms until it's their turn to perform.
 After performing, students will return to their classrooms to wait until the end of the concert.
- Choir students: The choir performs after the band so arrival is between 5:30 and 5:45 pm. Please go to your classroom upon arrival. Choir students will meet in the Music Room at 6:15 pm. After performing, they will return to their classroom.

Concert Start and Audience:

- Byng auditorium will open for seating at 5:30 pm so the concert can begin promptly at 6:00 pm.
- Entry for spectators is through the main auditorium entrance off Crown Street.
- Due to limited seating capacity in Byng auditorium, audience is limited to immediate family only, 2 spectators per student.
- Spectators are asked to stay for the entire performance, please.

Student Dismissal:

• Students will remain with their teachers in their classrooms before and can be picked up after the concert. Families, please exit Byng auditorium and pick up your children.

What to wear:

As a general and optional guideline, students may wear white tops and black bottoms.
 Maternelles (Kindergarten students) will be wearing blue and white. This is entirely optional, and all students are welcome to wear whatever they feel most comfortable in.

Please ensure your child comes to school dressed appropriately for cold and wet conditions. We recommend waterproof jackets, rain boots, and, as the temperatures drop, hats and mittens. Umbrellas are also welcome—just be sure to review safe and respectful umbrella use with your child.

We also strongly suggest keeping a spare set of clothes at school, including an extra pair of socks. This is especially important for younger students, as slips and falls are more common during wet weather, and having dry clothes on hand helps ensure comfort for the rest of the day.




