GOAL SETTING CONFERENCES – OCTOBER 22nd AND 23rd – 2:00 PM DISMISSAL:

Students will be dismissed at 2:00 pm on October 22nd and 23rd. Please ensure they are picked up promptly at 2:00 pm. An email through TEAMS Bookings will be sent to you to book your appt with your child's classroom teacher. NOTE: some teachers may have conferences on alternate days as well. If you require a TEAMs video conference, please let the classroom teacher know.

COMMUNICATION AND CONFLICT RESOLUTION:

When your child talks about an incident that happened at school that day and you have questions, please check in with your child's teacher. Very often, the situation may be more complex than your child's understanding of what may have happened, and the classroom teacher can help with a better understanding of each incident. Please be aware that there are privacy limitations in place for the protection of all students and families.

Also, if there is any misunderstanding or conflict, big or small, with your child's teacher, please take some time to check in with the classroom teacher before reaching out to me, the principal. I've included the VSB Conflict Resolution brochure for your reference. Thank you.
