Coyote Sightings

As it is the beginning of denning season for coyotes in Vancouver, there will be an increase in daytime sightings. This is expected and normal for coyotes at this time of year. We have already received reports of coyotes on our school grounds. According to the Urban Wildlife Program at the Stanley Park Ecology Society, none of the behaviour reported has indicated any signs of aggression. What should you do if a coyote approaches you?

- Be BIG, BRAVE and LOUD
- Big: stand up tall, put arms over your head
- Brave: stand your ground, don't run away, throw objects towards it
- Loud: shout "Go away!" in a deep, loud voice
