Core Competency Self-Reflections

All students will be completing their second self-reflection of the core competencies on Monday, April 8th during FIT. This is a Ministry of Education requirement for all K-12 students and needs to be completed three times each year.

On Monday, April 8th, students will be remaining with their Period 1 teacher for FIT time in order to complete this self-reflection activity.

Every course has unique curricular competencies that students need to demonstrate and that teachers assess as part of a student's grade. These curricular competencies directly relate to the core competencies. By the time a student is in grade 12, they should be able to identify all their strengths and weakness, as well as provide examples, as they reflect on their personal growth.
