### Literacy 10 Assesemnts

All grade 10 students will be registered automatically to write the grade 10 Literacy Assessment from April 15 – 19<sup>th</sup>. The schedule will be posted in Teams and across from the counselling suite after spring break. The Literacy 10 exam, along with the Numeracy 10, and Literacy 12 exam are required for graduation.

### Student Learning Survey

Immediately after completing their Literacy 10 exam, grade 10 students will stay at their computers to complete the Ministry’s Student Learning Survey. The Ministry’s Student Learning Survey is administered to grade 10 and 12 students every year. Student feedback is used by the Ministry of Education, local school Districts, and the schools to help with school planning goals and for supporting students. Grade 12 students will complete the survey at the end of April (after reviewing their Transcript Verification Reports).
