Cellphone Policy:



David Thompson continues to use the <u>stop light</u> <u>image</u> as a reminder for students to keep their personal digital devices (cellphones) off during instructional time.

Each class starts off with a **red light** meaning absolutely no digital devices.

If a teacher will be allowing students to use their personal devices during a portion of the class (ie: research, Slido, Kahoot, or any other educational related activity) then the teacher will announce that the light has changed to a yellow light. If a teacher announces it is a green light then a device can be used any time during the remainder of the class for educational purposes only. In each instance, the educator needs to give permission.
