**1. Welcome**

- a. Welcome to all to tonight's meeting, PAC Chair Regina is away, and Manj will be carrying forward with the meeting.
- b. Apology for rescheduling this meeting and for any confusion. Going forward all meetings will be on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the month at 530pm.

**3. Principles Update – Nick Akrap**

- a. Grade 8's had their rotation for the 2 subjects: ADST and Fine Arts. Grade 8s will have their Pumpkin Carving event during FIT time later this week.
- b. Tonight is a Grad movie night, part of their fundraising initiatives. Nick sent an email to parents advising them the movie is *Scream*.
- c. FIT time is being used very well, students are remembering to sign up and are planning their week ahead as teachers were hoping they would. Students are easily getting into the app and are showing up. Good Job Students and Teachers.
- d. All grades will have assemblies during FIT where the students will talk about the school code of conduct, discuss self reflections, review core competencies and how one can grow and implement themselves. The assemblies will go over the self reflection form and give students time to learn and reflect. It is mandatory for all students to do their self reflection form and it will be part of the students report card.
- e. Nov 6 is when students will stay in their home room and fill out the self reflection forms that will be part of their report card and something to reflect back on at the end of the grade.
- f. 2 new staff members at DT, they are part of the School Age Children and Youth (SACY Program) harm reduction with substance use for individuals and families and provide social and emotional support. Kim works directly with the school and Reneet works with

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the families. Nick will send an email with the resources and workshops that Reneet and the SACY offers.

- g. Interim Report Cards came out 2 weeks ago, it's a snapshot on how kids are doing in school.
