

SOOLIM CO SCHOLARSHIP

Value: \$2500.00 each

The key focus of this scholarship is to provide necessary financial assistance to a student who has been accepted to a post-secondary institution and who intends to pursue a degree in Science, Applied Sciences (Engineering), Math or Applied Math (Statistics or Actuarial Science).



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- has been accepted into an accredited post-secondary institution to a four-year program in Science or Applied Sciences (Engineering). Verification is required. UBC candidates will be considered even if acceptance has not yet been confirmed. Verification, however, will still be required later.
- has achieved an overall average of at least 86% in a **minimum of two** of the following courses: Biology AP, Calculus AB/BC (only one of the two may be used), Chemistry AP, Physics AP, Biology 12, Chemistry 12, and Physics 12. The courses **MUST** be taken at David Thompson during the regular school year.
- **MUST** submit a transcript, including second term marks, with your application.
- **MUST** clearly demonstrate financial need for post-secondary education (relevant details **MUST** be included - the information will be kept strictly confidential).
- is a Canadian citizen, has Permanent Residence status in Canada, or is a Landed Immigrant.

APPLICATION:

Electronically submit your application as an attachment to carpediemdtss@gmail.com by **April 1, 2025 by 4:00PM**. In the subject area of your email, type your name and the name of the scholarship you are apply for. No late submissions will be accepted.

Ensure that your name, student number, email address, and the scholarship for which you are applying is on the top of each page of your application.

Include the name of a teacher, administrator or a staff member, or a community mentor who is most familiar with the supplementary information provided in your application. A letter of recommendation **MUST** be submitted by your reference to support your application.

In your application, include the following information:

- answer the following questions in essay in 300-500 words:
 - What got you interested in math and/or sciences?
 - How has that impacted your educational and career goals and aspirations?
- indicate if you play a classical, orchestral, musical instrument and, if so, to which level (verification required).
- Include results from any completed AP courses.
- List any math and/or science competitions in which you have participated and the results you achieved (verification is required).
