
Basketball

Boundary Changes

Recently, the Vancouver School Board Trustees voted to approve the changes to the former Carleton catchment. In recent years, many families living in the Carleton catchment have had to travel to Cunningham Elementary or apply cross boundary to nearby schools (including Weir). After an engagement process with Cunningham, Weir, and MacCorkindale Elementary schools, the following changes were made. The Carleton catchment has now been divided into amongst the three schools with Weir receiving the largest portion of the catchment. No other changes have been made to the Weir catchment area. Our newly reconstructed, seismically safe building was a consideration in the formation of these boundaries.

Student Fees

We have had some questions lately regarding our school fees. The Vancouver School Board sets the student fee at \$35 per student for supplies; this fee has remained the same for many years. Unfortunately, the increase in costs of school supplies (glue sticks pencils, paint etc.) results in this money not going as far as it once did. Our teachers are very good at stretching this money and reusing supplies. However, there may be times where they request families purchase additional supplies as the classroom supply budget has been exhausted. As always, please reach out to us should financial constraints pose an obstacle to paying for these additional supplies. No student will ever be excluded from school activities or experiences due to family financial challenges.
