



Safe Arrival and Reporting Student Absences



To report your child's absence, please call **604-713-5159**, **Ext. 39**, prior to 9:00 am on the first day of the absence. If your child arrives late to school, they should report to the office and signin.

The Importance of being on time



Punctuality is an essential part of setting students up for success. Being on time ensures that your child—and their classmates—can begin the day without unnecessary disruptions. Many learning activities begin promptly at **9:00 a.m.**, so arriving on time allows your child to fully participate right from the start.

A welcome bell rings at 8:55 a.m., signaling students to line up and be greeted by their teacher. The instructional day begins at 9:00 a.m., and we aim for all students to be present, settled, and ready to learn.

Oismissal Reminder

Our school day ends at **2:58 p.m.** We kindly ask that all students are picked up on time. This is especially important for our younger students, who can become anxious or upset if a parent or caregiver is late.

Your efforts to support punctuality show respect for your child's learning, their teachers, and the school community.

Appointment for students during the school day

If your child has an appointment during school hours, please notify both the classroom teacher and the school office at least one day in advance, if possible. This helps us plan accordingly, especially if a neighbourhood walk or other off-site activity is scheduled.

When picking up your child, please come to the school office to sign them out.

All Vancouver students will move into their new divisions as soon as schools receive authorization from the District. Like all of you, students and families, teachers and school staff are ready to get going. Thank you for your ongoing patience and understanding.

Before and After School Playground Supervision



Please note that the front playground is supervised from **8:40 to 8:55 a.m.** and again from **2:58 to 3:13 p.m.**

At the start of the school day (9:00 a.m.), classroom teachers will meet students at their designated meeting spots and escort them into the school. At dismissal (2:58 p.m.), students will return to the same locations for parent pick-up.

For safety reasons, students not picked up by 3:13 p.m. will be brought to the office, and a parent or guardian will be contacted.

Welcome back to a new school year! I hope your summer was restful and that your family is settling smoothly into the rhythm of September.

My name is Jackie Ellis, and I'm the Area Counsellor here at Jules Quesnel. I'll be in the building every Thursday and Friday, and alternating Wednesdays. I'm here to support your children in a variety of ways. My role includes:

As a VSB Area Counsellor, I also work collaboratively with students, staff, families, and community agencies to support students' educational, personal, and emotional development.

A few resources that are offered are Family Smart and Kelty Mental Health Resource Centre. Below is a quick summary of their services being offered.

FamilySmart (www.familysmart.ca³)offers free support to parents and caregivers of children and youth (ages 0–24) who may be struggling with mental health or substance use. Highlights include:

- Free September Events on Emotional Regulation
- One-on-One Support via self-referral or professional referral
- Workshops & Presentations for school staff and parent groups

Kelty Mental Health Resource Centre (keltycentre@cw.bc.ca⁴) located at BC Children's Hospital. This provincial resource centre supports families across BC with children and youth up to age 24.

Services include:

- Peer Support from trained family support workers
- Help Navigating the Mental Health System
- Resources on topics like anxiety, ADHD, eating disorders, and emotional regulation
- Podcasts, Webinars, and Guides for parents and caregivers
- Support for School Communities and professionals


This consent allows teachers to take students on local walks within the neighbourhood or to nearby areas such as **Pacific Spirit Park** as part of their learning activities. Thank you.

Allergy Aware



The Vancouver School District and École Jules Quesnel are committed to providing as safe a learning and teaching environment as is practicable for anaphylactic students. In addition to the precautions taken by school staff and the families of allergic children, all JQ families are asked to be 'allergy-aware' and to consider the following strategies to minimize the risk of exposure for allergic children.

- Try to avoid sending your child to school with allergenic foods.
- Encourage your child to wash their hands regularly, especially before and after eating.
- Discourage sharing of food at school.

All VSB schools are also 'air aware', meaning students, staff and visitors are encouraged to use fragrance free and unscented shampoos, hairsprays, deodorants, lotions, and other products, and avoiding application of perfume and cologne. If your child has an appointment during the school day, please give both the teacher and school office sufficient notice of the pick-up time, at least a day, if possible, in case the teacher has a neighbourhood walk planned. Parents may come to the school office to collect and sign-out their child.
