French Immersion Kindergarten Siblings entering in September 2024

A reminder for families with a younger sibling entering Kindergarten this coming September, that after applying to your English catchment school, the last step is to register for a Choice Program between **now and February 2nd at 4 pm** at the following link: <u>https://kchoice.vsb.bc.ca/</u>

All JQ siblings are in priority group #1. The school will officially confirm your child's spot in late February once the VSB lottery has taken place.

Grade 1 Sibling(s) entering in September

Any families who may have a sibling who will enter grade 1 in September 2024, please notify the office. Grade 1 siblings receive priority registration provided they register before **January 31, 2024**.
