Update: Provincial government announced restrictions on cell phones in schools for September 2024

On Friday, January 26, the provincial government announced measures to improve student safety online. This included information about restricting cell phones in schools to be put in place by the next school year.

Currently, in the VSB, several measures are in place to guide appropriate use of cell phones and other devices. These include the District Student Code of Conduct⁵ and Acceptable Use of Technology⁶ administrative procedures. Staff will work with the Ministry of Education and Child Care to ensure that any necessary changes are implemented ahead of September 2024. More information will be shared as it becomes available.


Next week, all students will participate in dance lessons during their regular PE sessions. Have your child wear comfortable clothing on their gym day.

Conferences - February 14 & 15, early dismissal for all students at 2 pm





Traffic Safety

Parents may wish to review traffic safety with their children.

Students can follow some simple road safety guidelines to prevent pedestrian injuries:

- Always cross streets at corners where there are traffic signals and designated crosswalks.
- Make eye contact with drivers before crossing on front of them.
- Always walk on sidewalks.
- Be aware of cars that are turning or backing up.
- Never run out into the street or cross between parked cars.
- Don't text and walk.
- Younger children should walk to school with a buddy.

Drivers can also enhance traffic safety with the following practices:

- Respect the 30 km/hr school zones and playground zones.
- Do not stop in a "No Stopping" zone for any reason.
- Do not park in a "No Parking" zone.

- Do not pass other vehicles in a school zone.
- Do not double park or park on the wrong side of the street to pick up or drop off.
- Do not drive into the school parking lot to pick-up or drop-off children.
- Do not make U-turns, back up or make 3 point turns in a school zone.

If your children walk to school

- Pedestrians should wear bright or light coloured clothing to be visible to drivers.
- Pedestrians must look both ways for approaching traffic when crossing the road.


